Are you planning to sit the CICM Part I examination within the next year? Then this course is for you!

We teach exam preparation and technique, with a focus on strategies to improve your learning, short answer and viva performance.

About the Canberra Primary course

The Canberra Primary Course aims to prepare candidates for participating in the College of Intensive Care Medicine Primary examination. This course is suitable for those candidates beginning their preparation for the Primary Examination in Intensive Care Medicine. Ideally participants would be 6-18 months from their exam sitting.

Course content

The focus of this course will be on study and examination technique. There will not be lectures on syllabus material.

The course will include formal lectures as well as opportunities for viva and written exam practice in more supported as well as examination style environments. A psychologist experienced in exam preparation will give both lectures and small group sessions.

The course is limited to 20 registrants to allow a small group atmosphere and maximize exposure to our course faculty and CICM examiners.

Fee for the three-day course is \$900. This includes all course content, compendium, morning tea, lunch & afternoon tea each day, and course dinner.
